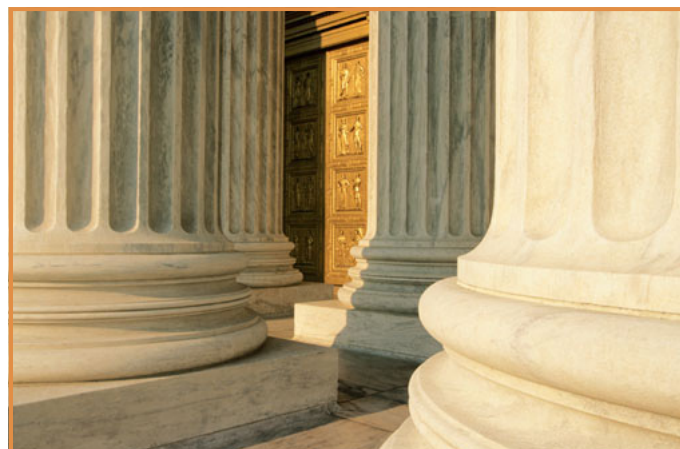

## CONVENTION SUMMARY

**Friday:** Opening Session begins at 7 p.m. and runs until 8 p.m. Following Opening Session, a welcome reception will be held from 8 to 9 p.m. With the convention hotel located minutes from Georgetown and one block from the Metro, D.C. nightlife is easily accessible.

**Saturday:** Convention sessions begin at 10:30 a.m. with keynote speaker author and journalist David Mark. Mr. Mark is a noted political journalist whose new book, *Going Dirty: The Art of Negative Campaigning*, has received mention in *The Economist*.

Mr. Mark has also appeared on *The Daily Show*, CNN, and many other media outlets as a political commentator.

Five blocks will follow featuring debates, discussions, and other activities. Convention programs end at 5:30 p.m.

**Sunday:** Convention sessions resume at 10:30 a.m. with Block Six. Sunday consists of two blocks and the Closing Session. The convention and all activities will conclude by 1:00 p.m.
